- 1) **Passage:** Three Kinds of Water www.readworks.org

Item Prompt: What is water called when it is a gas?

- A. drops
- B. heat
- C. steam

Correct answer: C

Misconceptions:

- A. Students may choose in error since tiny drops of water are what steam is made of.
- B. Students may choose in error since steam creates heat.
- C. **Correct answer.**

Item Prompt: What form of water is used for drinking?

- A. gas
- B. liquid
- C. solid

Correct answer: B

Misconceptions:

- A. Students may confuse the different forms of water.
- B. **Correct answer.**
- C. Students may misinterpret that ice cubes keep drinks cold.
