

### Vertical Progression:

<b>Kinder</b>	<b>RL K.1</b> With prompting and support, ask and answer questions about key details in a text.
<b>1<sup>st</sup> Grade</b>	<b>RL 1.1</b> <b>Ask and answer questions about key details in a text.</b>
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> Grade</b>	<b>RL 2.1</b> Ask and answer such questions as who, what, where, when, why, and how to demonstrate understanding of key details in a text .
